For soil fill that is of a quality suitable to be accepted at the United Soils Management Clean Fill Facility the following information may be added to the Excess Soil Destination Assessment report, prepared in accordance with Section B 4 of Part I of the *Rules for Soil Management and Excess Soil Quality Standards*:

Quality of Excess Soil Accepted	Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, Table 2 Full Depth Generic Site Condition Standards in a Potable Ground Water Condition for Agricultural or Other (AO) Property Use with the exception of Electrical Conductivity (EC) and Sodium Adsorption Ratio (SAR), from <i>Soil, Ground Water and Sediment Standards for Use under Part XV.1 of the Environmental Protection Act</i> , 2011. In addition, concentrations of benzo[a]pyrene, benzo[b]fluoranthene, benzo[k]fluoranthene, dibenz[a,h]anthracene, 1,2-dichlorobenzene and 2,4,6-trichlorophenol are acceptable if they meet Ontario Regulation 406/19 Table 2.1 Excess Soil Quality Standards (ESQS) for AO property use.
